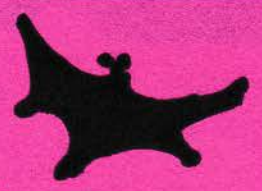

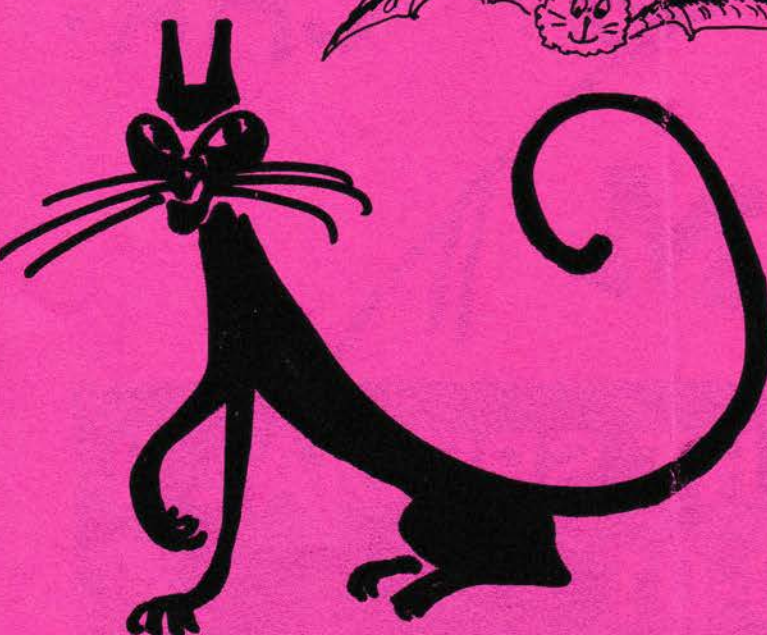

The constant shrieking won't stop in my head! Bad! Bad! I'm so bad!

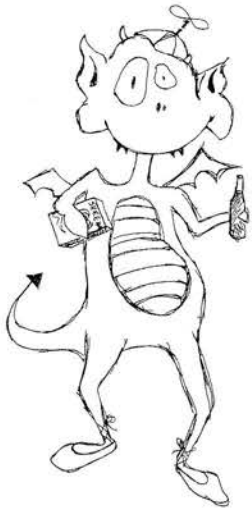
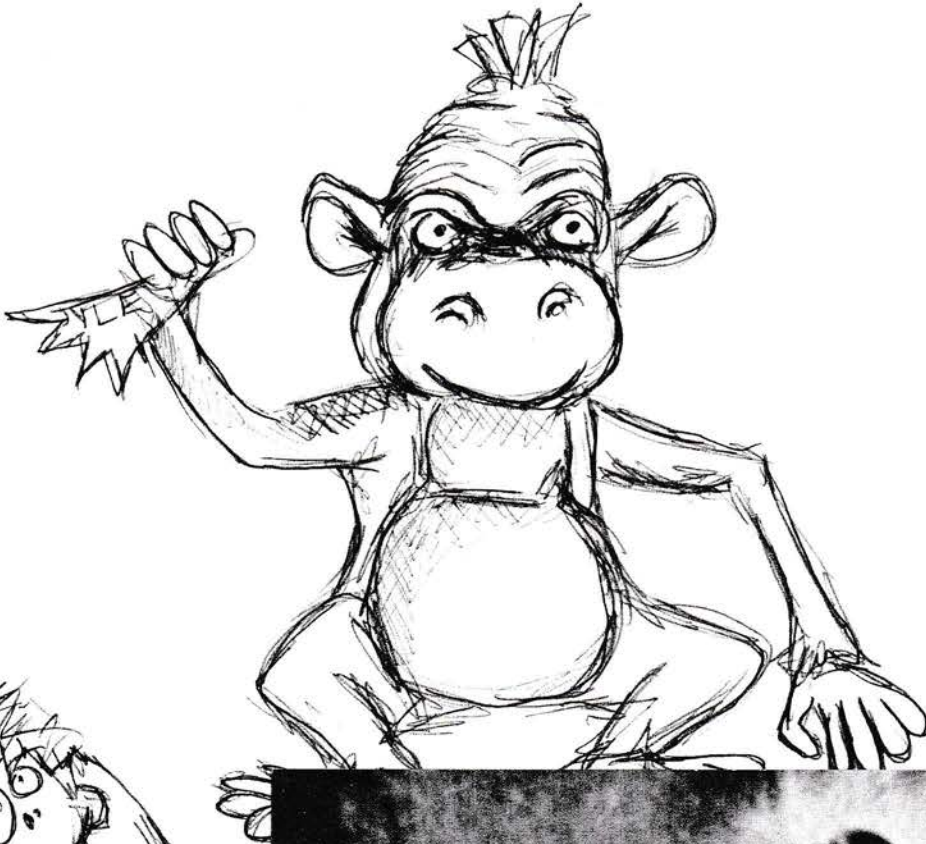

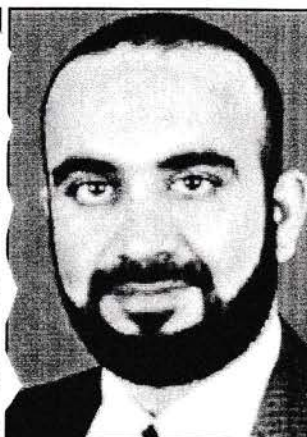
USAMA

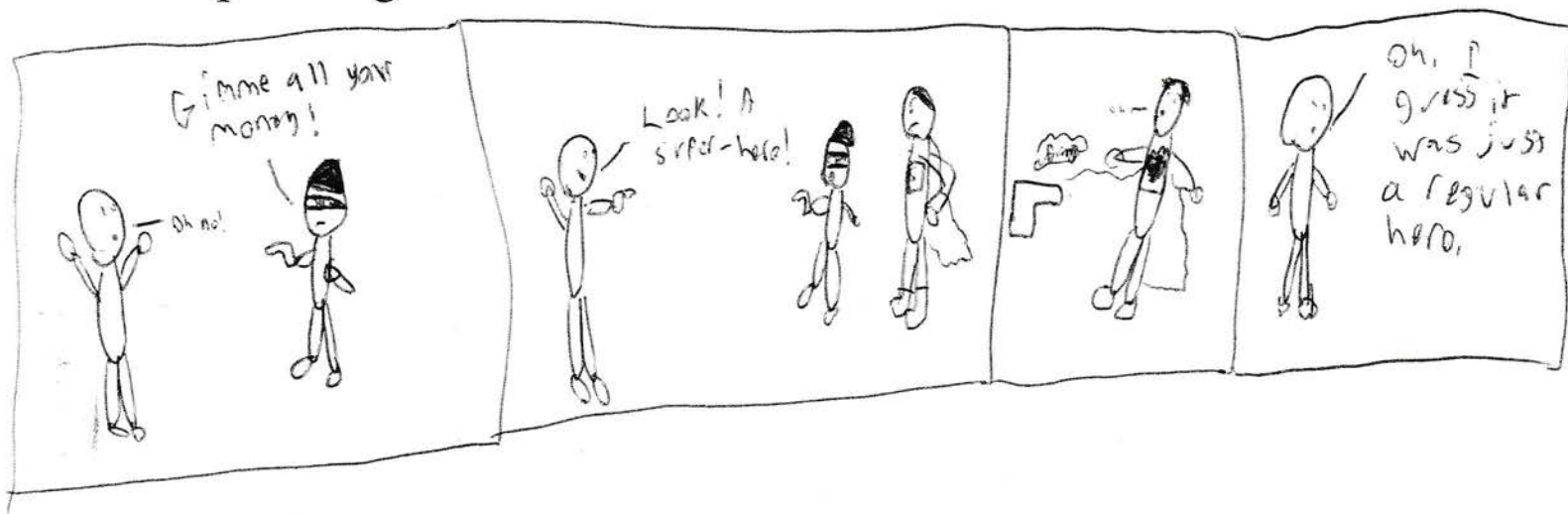

Garg: Very interesting. How much power do you expect to get from that generator?

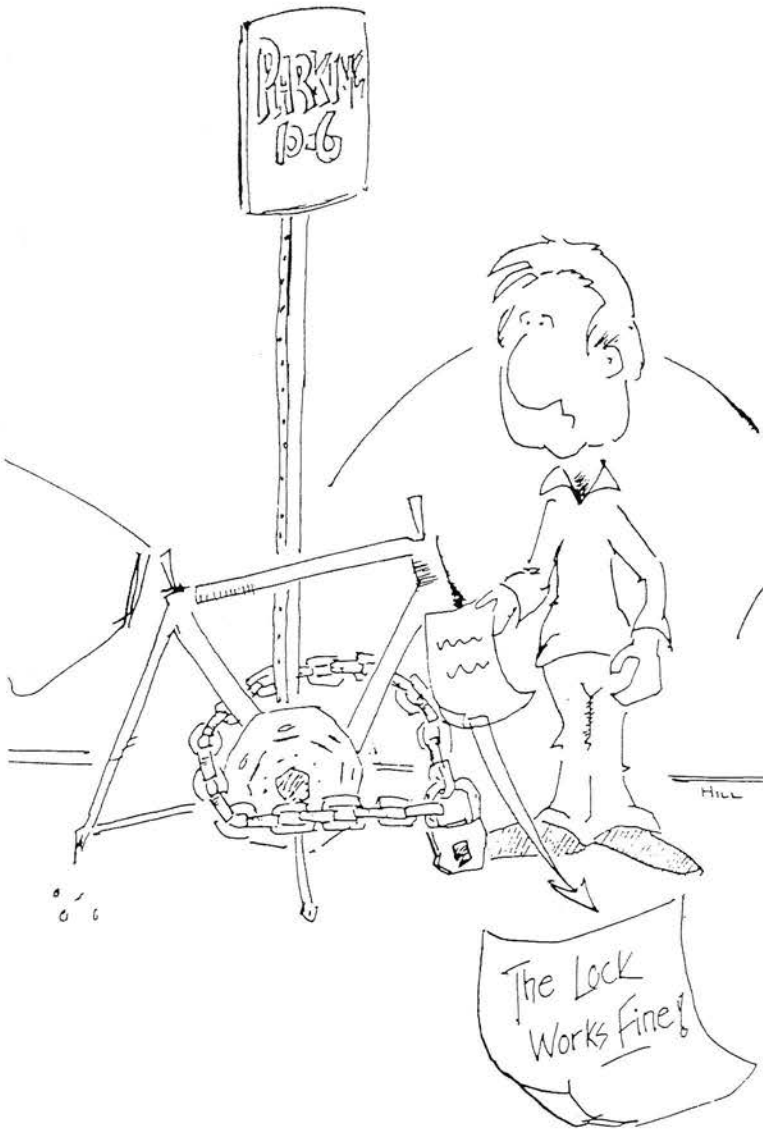
P.P.: Oh, I'd say about 50,000 mouse power. It could go much higher if the moist air updraft from the Administration Bldg. is taken into account.

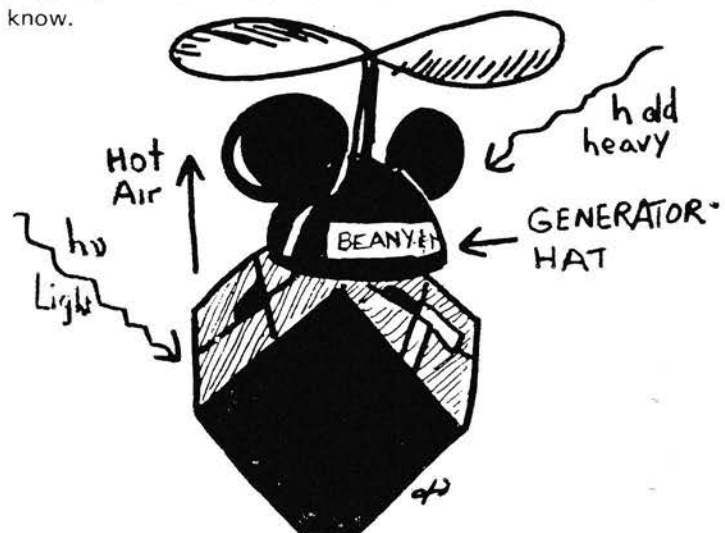

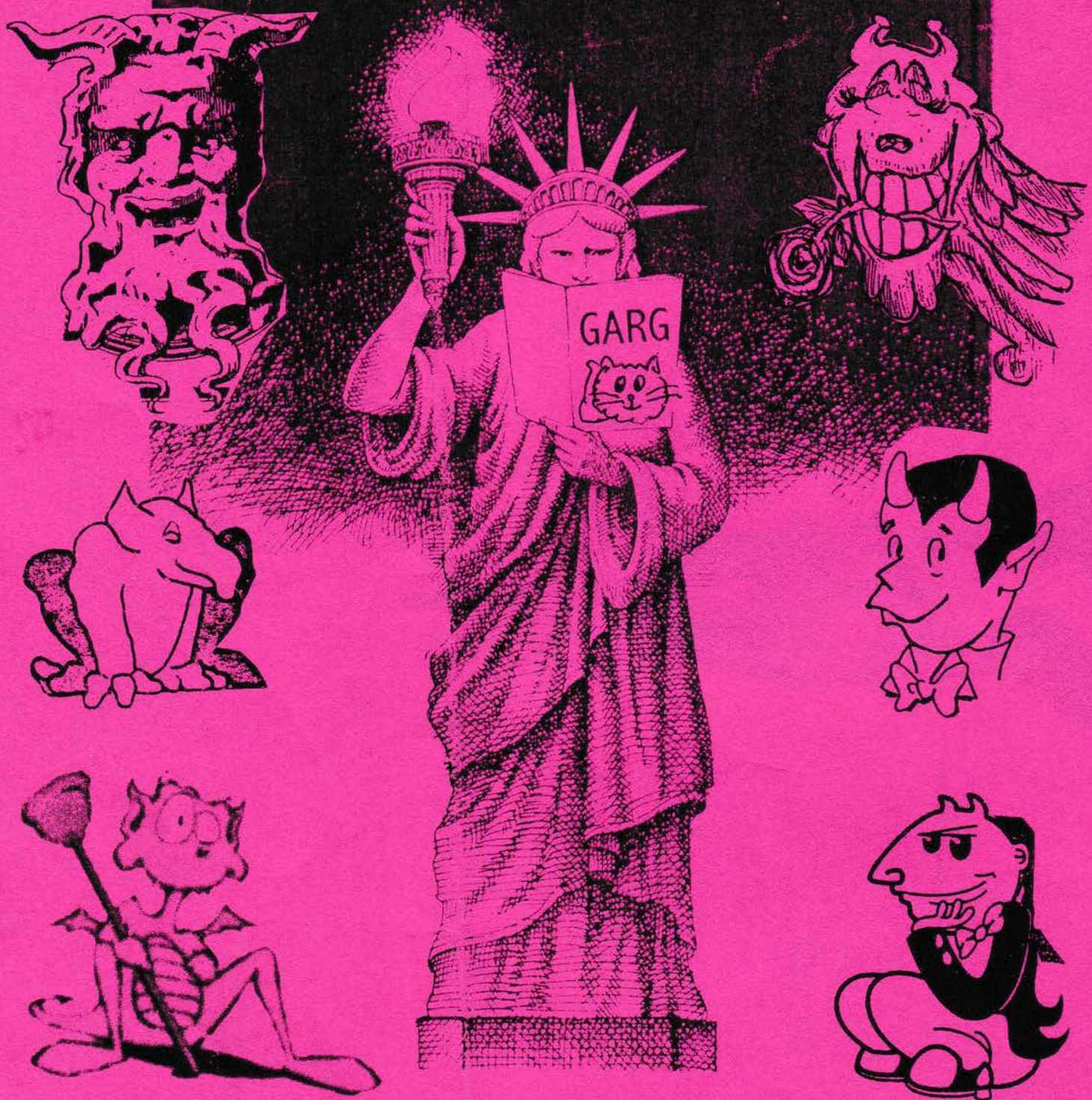
